

THE USE OF SCHOOLOGY MEDIA IN ENGLISH LEARNING EVALUATION PROCESS

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Abstract

This study aims to find out the effectiveness of Schoology media in English Learning evaluation process. Evaluation is one of activity learning process that should be done by teacher, in this case, teachers to be able to do the evaluation process to know how far their students had understood about the learning process. However, there are some difficulties for teachers to do evaluation in learning process. It is very important for the teachers to use interesting media to help them in evaluation process. This study aims to find out the effectiveness of Schoology in English learning. The study was conducted in one of Senior High Schools in Tangerang Banten named SMAIT Asy-Syukriyyah. 1. Introduction

Prasetya Irawan explained that the learning process is the responsibility of the teacher in developing all the potential that exists in students. The main purpose of the learning process is to change the behavior of students based on the objectives that have been planned and arranged by the teacher before the learning process takes place. Changes in behavior include intellectual aspects. To produce and know the students' absorption learning and to know changes in behavior, evaluation is one of the most urgent things to do. Because Evaluation is seen as input obtained from the learning process that can be used to find out the strengths and weaknesses of the various components contained in a learning process (Sawaludin, 2018:40).

One way to carry out the evaluation process is to carry out an assessment process. Assessment is the process of understanding, attitudes, and motivation of students which can be done through tests, self-assessments, both formally and informally. Testing is one of the procedures that can be used to assess student performance. The test can be objective or subjective. The test is

also a method for measuring a person's ability, knowledge or performance in a particular domain. gathering information to determine the extent to which learning objectives have been set. The information can be in the form of teacher opinions, parents, book quality, results. assessment and student attitudes. Evaluation tools can be in the form of tests, questionnaires, interviews, and observations (Nunung, 2014: 73-74).



One of the media that can be used is schoology. Schoology is an online media that can help teachers in the process of retrieving test scores or student evaluations quickly and practically. Thus, the researcher wants to try to do a research using schoology in the assessment process in learning English in grade 12 of science SMAIT Asy-syukriyyah Tangerang Banten.

Schoology is an online learning management system (LMS) designed to make online education a collective effort and to increase the overall impact of everyone involved in a student's education. A Learning Management System (LMS) is a software application or Web-based technology used to plan, implement, and access a specific learning process. Typically, a learning management system provides an

instructor with a way to create and deliver content, monitor student assess student participation, and performance (Rouse, 2005). Schoology is similar to Facebook's appearance and function. Schoology allows keeping of attendance records, online gradebooks, administration of tests and quizzes. Schoology's mission is to empower teachers, giving tools and connections to engage students more efficiently and improve educational effectiveness. A teacher can assign and grade work on schoology, students can get help from the entire class on schoology (Avilia, 2018: 42).

Modul Pelatihan Pemanfaatan E-Learning Schoology written by Universitas Darussalam Gontor explains that in Schoology, we can make some Courses Material (Assignments). To make quiz in Schoology, we can follow steps below:

 - b. Due Date


c. Category

Schoology can be a tool for learning evaluation. Etymologically "evaluation" is derived from English and is an evaluation of the root word value which means value or price. Values in Arabic are called Al-Qiamah or Al-Tagdir 'which means evaluation. Whereas literally, educational evaluation in Arabic is often referred to as Al-Tagdir Al-Tarbiyah, which is interpreted as an assessment in the field of education or an assessment of matters relating to educational activities. In terminology, some experts give an opinion on the meaning of evaluation including: Edwind Ramayulis said that evaluation implies an action or process in determining the value of something. while M. Chabib Thoha, defines evaluation is a planned activity to determine the state of the object by using instruments and the results are compared with benchmarks obtain conclusions (Mahirah, to 2017:258).

According to Joko Widiyanto (2018: 9) said that evaluation is a systematic, comprehensive process that includes measurement, assessment, analysis and interpretation of information / data to determine the extent to which students have achieved the learning objectives undertaken. The aim of it is to find out the level of success of an educational program, teaching, or conducted. While Arifin (2013: 5) argues evaluation is essentially systematic and ongoing process to determine the quality (value and meaning) of something, based on certain considerations and criteria in order to make a decision (Asrul et all, 2014: 4).

Thus, it can be concluded that evaluation is a process arranged systematically to determine the value or quality of an object so that the success rate of an activity carried out by the object can be seen.

One of the roles of evaluation in the context of the learning process is to give consideration to the quality of the learning process. Furthermore, the evaluation results are used to improve the learning process leading to better quality because an evaluation of the effective learning process is expected to provide useful information for teachers to improve the effectiveness of the learning process. In addition, evaluation students can be used to improve the quality of their learning activities (Ghufron and Sutama, 2011: 1.8).

In the evaluation process in the learning process we can do a process called assessment. Assessment can be used in various ways or tools to measure results during the learning process. According to Arifin and Djiwandono, explained that assessment of the process and learning outcomes are divided into four types, namely formative assessment, summative assessment, diagnostic assessment, and placement assessment. The following explanation of the four types assessment. Thus, the assessment can be done based on an educational calendar that has been determined by the organizer. Assessment is the process of gathering various data that can provide an overview of the learning progress of students explain and interpret the results of measurements, describe information about the extent of learning outcomes or achievement of student competencies (Aryana, 2019).


2. Method


3. Result and Discussion
